● Mako Periscope - Secure Remote Access

We've released the preview edition of Mako Periscope, a secure remote access service where you can securely access web-based applications hosted on the LAN of a Mako simply by selecting them in the Mako CMS.

CMS R8580 - Maintenance

- General: Added Site ID and Company ID information to the Mako Information Popup.
- Labels: Fixed regression in acceptable label values. Labels can now include uppercase/lowercase letters, numbers, periods and dashes.
- PCI: Fixed issue preventing the deletion of a VLAN that has previously had a vulnerability scan performed on it.
- Reports: Added back report by destination IP.
- Reports: Fixed issue with historic daily usage data not being displayed when viewing data older than 2 months ago.
- Reports: Fixed issue with reports with a custom date range spanning more than a month.
- Reports: Improved performance of PC Usage reporting.
- Review: The config review screen is now available to all Makos, not just PCI Makos.
- Syslogs: The name column is now included as part of syslog search queries.
