CPE F6250 - Features and Improvements

- DSL: Added PPPoA support for DSL on the Mako 6600 series.
- Hotspot: Added Hotspot support to Mako 4600 series.
- IPsec: Added ability to run IPsec on any WAN or LAN, not just the default route.
- SNMP: Added SNMP support to Make 4600 series.

- Diagnostics: Fixed issue with Bridge Status diagnostics on Mako 4600, 6600, 7600, 8600 series.
- Diagnostics: Fixed issue with MakoScope not showing VLANs for access points.
- DNS: Fixed issue with the Mako's internal DNS client lookups not working over a VPN.
- DSL: Added ability to override interface MAC address for DSL on Mako 6600 series.
- Firewall: Fixed issue with responding to ARP queries sent to the wrong interface.
- Hotspot: Fixed issue with Hotspot becoming unresponsive under certain circumstances.
- Hotspot: Fixed issue with Hotspot unable to register under clients certain circumstances.

- Hotspot: Fixed issue with Hotspot configuration change not being applied under certain circumstances.
- IDS: Fixed IDS logs not being included in remote syslogs.
- Internet: Fixed issue with DHCP lease renewal failing in certain situations.
- SFP: Fixed issue with bridging a SFP port to a LAN on Mako 6600 sesries.
- SNMP: Fixed issue with cellular interface status on 6600 series.
- VPN Cloud: Fixed issue where watchdog did not restart the VPN Cloud process on remote peers when it should.
- Wi-Fi: Fixed compatibility issue with IoT (ESP 8266) devices connecting to Mako 4600 series Wi-Fi networks.
- Wi-Fi: Fixed issue with a brief connectivity loss when adding VLAN interfaces on access points.
